About the role:

The role of the fitter is to ensure our products are built/assembled/adapted in compliance with designs and specifications and to production schedules. You will also be required to maintain stock levels in accordance with company policy.

Duties:

- Fitting and assembly of machine parts to engineering drawings.
- Completion of basic plastic and steel fabrication

- Drilling and tapping of components when necessary.
- Strip/ prepare machines/tooling for dispatch.
- Monitor progress of build against required delivery dates.
- Report on build progress and advise where build may not meet deadlines.
- Work with engineers and other staff, contractors or clients to ensure provision of a quality product.
- Safe and secure storage of parts and other consumables, reporting component shortages and making recommendations for consumables.
- Maintain project equipment and record equipment usage.
- Ensure tools and equipment are maintained in a clean, complete and safe condition in accordance with company and quality standards.
- Continuously monitor part delivery and quality.
- Ensure cleanliness and tidiness of all work areas.
- Ensure personal, protective equipment is issued and worn in all workshop areas.
