As an onsite, Production Sprayer, you will be responsible for the accurate application of various paint systems including gel coating for moulds and parts, to a high standard, to meet customer specifications and production targets.

Duties:

- Responsible for the application of the Gel Coat, to a finish, on fibre glass parts
- Responsible for fibre-glass lay-up, using pneumatic spray gun.
- Responsible for identifying imperfections
- Maintain records of thickness of each part
- Responsible for in-build repairs
- Responsible for the safe operation of plant, equipment and/or hand tools associated with the paint-preparation & paint processes.

- Takes full responsibility for quality, quantity and inspection of work performed.
- Good understanding of customer deliverables and the impact of failure and cost of poor quality.
- Ability to work hard to maintain constantly changing product flow through a busy production environment.
- Ability to work on own initiative to resolve any wet spray paint related issues.
- Ability to work accurately and efficiently.
- Ability to comprehend and follow verbal and written instructions.
- Strong team working ethic, with the drive and flexibility to maintain pace of work as priorities and requirements change.
